## **APPENDIX**

A **Section 3 worker** is any worker who currently fits, or when hired within the past five years fit, at least one of the following categories, as documented:

- 1. The worker's income for the previous or annualized calendar year is below the income limit established by HUD;
- 2. The worker is employed by a Section 3 business concern; or
- 3. The worker is a Youth Build participant.

A **Section 3 targeted worker** for Public Housing Financial Assistance projects is a Section 3 worker who:

- (1) is employed by a Section 3 business concern; or
- (2) currently fits or when hired fit at least one of the following categories, as documented within the past five years:
  - (i) A resident of public housing or Section 8-assisted housing;
  - (ii) A resident of other public housing projects or Section 8-assisted housing managed by the PHA that is providing the assistance; or
  - (iii) A Youth Build participant

Low- and very low-income limits are defined in Section 3(b)(2) of the Housing Act of 1937 and are determined annually by HUD. These limits are typically established at 80 percent and 50 percent of the area median individual income for the <a href="City/County of Sacramento">City/County of Sacramento</a>. ## A Section 3 Business is:

- 1. At least, 51% owned by current low or very low income persons; or
- 2. Over 75% of the labor hours performed by the business, are performed by low or very low income persons; or
- 3. At least, 51% of the business must be owned by current public housing residents or residents that currently live in Section 8 (HCV) housing.
